Jim Durso is going to be testing some auxiliary lighting techniques to be used with digital cameras, thus saving money on regular photo processing for this project. Any one who owns a digital camera is encouraged to bring it to the November meeting so these tests can be made and logged in order to hopefully achieve a better image quality for each particular camera. Photos of contest winning models will be taken using conventional film and processing immediately following those events.

Our November program will be a model car building Q & A forum highlighted by several individual brief demonstrations on techniques and detailing tips. Included will be the use of unusual "tools", unconventional detail "parts", body fillers, prep and paint, and other non-ordinary (we think) tips. The lineup so far is as follows:

Andy Such (pending): Common junk found around the house that can be used for detailing. If time permits he may show us how to stretch sprue for use as.....whatever.

Joe Vasapollo: Unconventional tools and supplies used for model building.

Bill Garner: Automotive body fillers, putties, and paints available for basic and custom body finishing.

Fernando Roman: A demonstration on using Marine Tex for body work.

Jim Durso: Modifying window glass from old kits for a cleaner fit.

Wyatt Erb: Metal parts he makes for car details and an overview of the severe body modifications he performs to create custom made street vehicles. ■
